2. You must respond to this summons and petition by serving a copy of your written response on the person signing this summons and by filing the original with the clerk of the court. If you do not serve your written response within 20 days (or 60 days if you are served outside of the State of Washington) after the date this summons was served on you, exclusive of the day of service, the court may enter an order of default against you, and the court may, without further notice to you, enter a decree and approve or provide for the relief requested in the petition. In the case of a dissolution of marriage, the court will not enter the final decree until at least 90 days after filing and service. If you serve a notice of appearance on the undersigned person, you are entitled to notice before an order of default or a decree may be entered.
3. Your written response to the summons and petition must be on form WPF DR 01.0300, Response to Petition (Domestic Relations). This form may be obtained by contacting



5 1.4 ALLEGATION REGARDING MARRIAGE.

6 This marriage is irretrievably broken.

7 1.5 DATE AND PLACE OF MARRIAGE.

10 Husband and wife separated on the date this petition was filed with the court.

11 1.7 JURISDICTION.

12 This court has jurisdiction over the marriage.

15 The petitioner and respondent lived in Washington during their marriage and the
16 petitioner continues to reside, or be a member of the armed forces stationed, in
this state.

17 The petitioner and respondent may have conceived a child while within
18 Washington.

19 1.8 PROPERTY.

20 There is community or separate property owned by the parties. The court should make a
fair and equitable division of all the property.

21 The petitioner's recommendation for the division of property will be provided at a
22 later date.

23 1.9 DEBTS AND LIABILITIES.

24 The petitioner's recommendation for the division of debts and liabilities will be
provided at a later date.

1.10 SPOUSAL MAINTENANCE.

There is a need for spousal maintenance.

1.11 CONTINUING RESTRAINING ORDER.

Does not apply.

1.12 PREGNANCY.

The wife is not pregnant.

1.13 JURISDICTION OVER THE CHILDREN.

This court has jurisdiction over the children for the reasons set forth below.

This state is the home state of the children because the children lived in Washington with a parent or a person acting as a parent for at least six consecutive months immediately preceding the commencement of this proceeding.

The children and the parents or the children and at least one parent or person acting as a parent, have significant connection with the state other than mere physical presence; and substantial evidence is available in this state concerning the children's care, protection, training and personal relationships and the children have no home state elsewhere.

15 Washington State Child Support Schedule.


16 Divide the property and liabilities.
