I. MOTION

Based upon the declaration below, the undersigned moves the court for a temporary order and order to show cause.

1.1 EX PARTE RESTRAINING ORDER.

A temporary restraining order should be granted without written or oral notice to the other party or the other party's lawyer because immediate and irreparable injury, loss, or damage will result before the other party or the other party's lawyer can be heard in opposition. This order should restrain or enjoin:

The husband from transferring, removing, encumbering, concealing or in any way disposing of any property except in the usual course of business or for the necessities of life and requiring each party to notify the other of any extraordinary expenditures made after the order is issued.

The husband from molesting or disturbing the peace of the other party or of any child.

The husband from removing any of the children from the State of Washington.

1 The husband from assigning, transferring, borrowing, lapsing, surrendering or  
2 changing entitlement of any insurance policies of either or both parties whether  
3 medical, health, life or auto insurance.

4 The other party should be required to appear and show cause why these restraints  
5 should not be continued in full force and effect pending final determination of this action.

6  
7 1.2 OTHER EX PARTE RELIEF

8 Order that the wife shall be the parent with whom the children reside until the hearing.

9  
10 1.3 SURRENDER OF DEADLY WEAPONS.

11 Does not apply.

12  
13 1.4 OTHER TEMPORARY RELIEF.

14 The husband should also be required to appear and show cause why the court should  
15 not enter a temporary order which:

16 Awards to the wife custody of the minor children.

17 Awards to the husband visitation as agreed to by the parties.

18 Orders temporary family support in the amount of one-half husband's  
19 income each month.


20 Orders the husband to maintain the vehicle and medical insurance for the  
21 wife and children.

22 Authorizes the family home to be occupied by the wife.

23 Requires the husband to vacate the family home.

24 Orders the husband to pay the house and all community bills.


